1 Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEE]

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it would therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will accordingly allow a "preference" to companies who provide a B-BBEE Verification Certificate. All procurement transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

1.1 B-BBEE Scorecard and Rating

As prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are to note the following:

- Proposals will be evaluated on price which will be allocated 80 points and preference which will be allocated 20 points, dependent on the value of the Services
- The 80/20 preference point system applies where the acquisition of the Services will be less than R1 000 000.00
- If the 80/20 preference point system is stipulated and all Bids received exceed R1 000 000.00, the RFP will be cancelled

In compliance with the Government Gazette No. 4612, Notice No. 754 dated 23 September 2011, as from 1 October 2011 valid B-BBEE Verification Certificates must be issued by:

- a) Verification Agencies accredited by the South African National Accreditation System [SANAS]; or
- b) Registered Auditors approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors [IRBA], in accordance with the approval granted by the Department of Trade and Industry.

Enterprises will be rated by such agencies based on the following:

- c) **Large Enterprises** [i.e. annual turnover greater than R35 million]:
 - Rating level based on all seven elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- d) **Qualifying Small Enterprises – QSE** [i.e. annual turnover between R5 million and R35 million]:
 - Rating based on any four of the elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- e) **Exempted Micro Enterprises – EME** [i.e. annual turnover less than R5 million]:

In accordance with B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice [Statement 000, Section 4], any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R 5 million or less qualifies as an EME.

- Automatic rating of B-BBEE Level 4 irrespective of race or ownership
- Black ownership greater than 50% or Black Women ownership greater than 50% automatically qualify as B-BBEE Level 3

Sufficient evidence to qualify as an EME would be a certificate (which may be in the form of a letter) from an auditor or accounting officer or a certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS. The certificate must confirm the company's turnover, black ownership / black female ownership and B-BBEE status level.



Respondents are required to furnish proof of the above to Transnet. [i.e. a detailed scorecard as stipulated above in respect of Large Enterprises and QSEs, or a certificate in respect of EMEs].

Transnet will accordingly allocate a maximum of **20 [twenty] points** in accordance with the **80/20** preference point system prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations to the Respondent's final score based on an entity's B-BBEE scorecard rating.

N.B. Failure to submit a B-BBEE certificate, which is valid as at the Closing Date of this RFP, will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

2 Evaluation Criteria

Transnet will utilise the following criteria in choosing a Supplier/Service Provider:-

- Weighted evaluation based on 80/20 preference point system:

Transnet will utilise the following formula in its evaluation of Price:

$$\bullet \text{ PS} = 80 \left(1 - \frac{\text{Pt} - \text{Pmin}}{\text{Pmin}} \right)$$

Where:

P_s = Score for the Bid under consideration

P_t = Price of Bid under consideration

P_{min} = Price of lowest acceptable Bid

- B-BBEE status of company

Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

DEFINITIONS

Domestic water: *Household water suitable for drinking, cooking etc.*

Dust suppression: *means any type of Hard or raw water with no toxic or hazardous substances*

ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENT

- Private property around the allocated sites must be respected.
- Dumping or polluting of any kind will not be permitted.
- The Contractor shall ensure that his/her employees at all times exercise care and consideration for the fauna and flora within and adjacent to the work area

HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

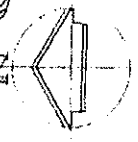
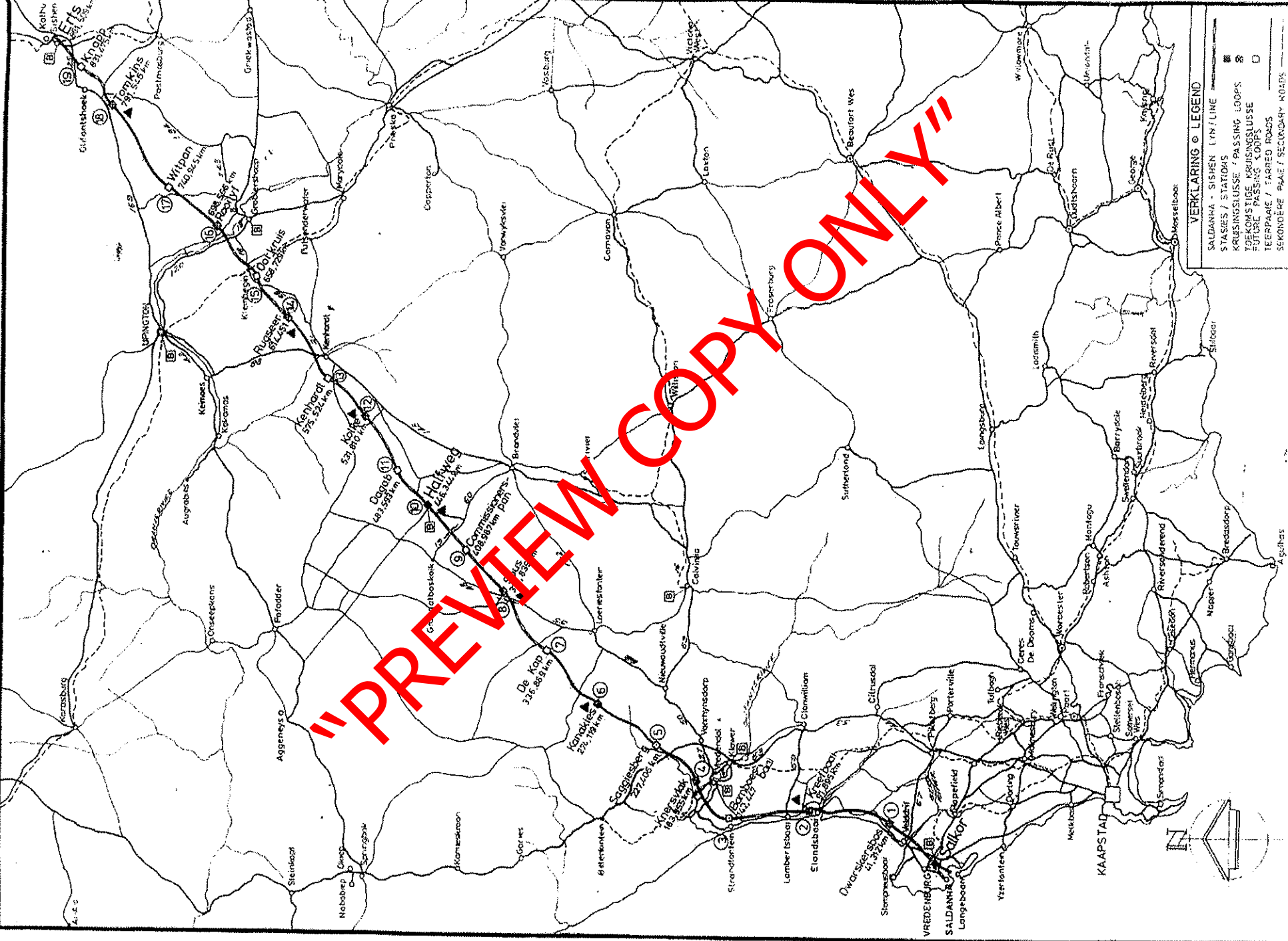
- The Contractor shall ensure that all workers are fit for duty and are appropriately equipped and wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and most specifically a yellow reflective vest.
- The Contractor shall be responsible to ensure that his/her staff go through the Transnet Freight Rail Safety Induction.

TO BE PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACTOR

- The Contractor shall provide all accommodation and toilet facilities for his/her employees.
- The Contractor shall supply and maintain suitable tools, plant and equipment to Supply water to on-track machinery
- The contractor shall provide **adequate horse (pipes) for supplying water to the on-track machinery the length of horse (pipes) should be approximately ± 80 m**
- The contractor shall provide **roadworthy vehicles/trucks with pumps with sufficient capacity**
- The Contractor shall provide at his/her own cost any security measures he/she may deem necessary for safe and effective execution of the work within the contract area.
- The contractor shall provide Protective Equipment (PPE) for his/her employees
- An effective safety procedure to be followed by all personnel on any Transnet Freight Rail work site shall be compiled by the Contractor and implemented before any work commences. The procedure shall be updated whenever the need arises and any changes shall be communicated to all employees on a work site before work proceeds.

DURATION OF CONTRACT

The work provides for the supply of domestic and dust suppression over a **12 days** period
