B-BBEE and preferencing scheme:

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it is strongly of the opinion that all South African business enterprises have an equal obligation to redress the imbalances of the past.

Transnet would therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values and who are prepared to contribute to meaningful B-BBEE initiatives (including, but not limited to subcontracting and Joint Ventures) as part of their tender responses. Transact will accordingly allow a "preference" in accordance with the 10% preference system, as per the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2000 (as amended), to companies who provide a B-LBET Accreditation Certificate. All procurement and disposal transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

Consequently, when Transnet invites prospective suppliers to sub-hit tenders for its various capital expenditure programmes, it urges tenderers (Large Enterprises and QSE's - see below) to have themselves accredited by any one of the various Accreditation Agencies approved by SANAS (the South African National Accreditation Systems under the auspices of the Department of Trade and Industry) and IRBA (Independent Regulatory Board for Auditors).
