12. BROAD-BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT ("BBBEE")

TRANSNET fully endorses and supports the South African Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it is strongly of the opinion that all business enterprises have an equal obligation to redress the imbalances of the past. TRANSNET would therefore prefer to do business with business enterprises who share these same values and who are prepared to contribute to meaningful BBBEE initiatives (including and not limited to enterprise development, subcontracting and Joint Ventures) as part of their tender response.

Transnet would accordingly allow a "preference" in accordance with the 10% preference system, as per the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2000 (as amended) to companies who provide a BBBEE accreditation Certificate. All procurement and disposal transactions in excess of R30000 will be evaluated accordingly. All transactions below R 30,000 will as far as possible be earmarked for EME's.

BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1. <u>SCOPE</u>

- 1.1 Transnet is in the process of systematically replacing copper cable infrastructure and aging optical fibre cables. The transmission equipment generally operates at the 1310 to 1625 nm wavelengths. Future DWDM applications will be a definite requirement.
- 1.2 Tenders are called for the supply of 24, 36, and 48 fibre, aerial self-support, underground duct and CST armoured cable on an "as and when required" basis over the next 2 years.
- 1.3 Pricing quoted must include ROE forward cover, transportation, and customs clearing. Delivery must be quoted for separately and indicated as a 'cents per kilometre' (cpk). Failure to do so will result in disqualification, as it will be impossible to compare the bids of the Tenderers.

- 1.4 Cable details and predicted quantities to be ordered are provided in the Schedule of Requirements (Annexure A), which must be read in conjunction with this enquiry. These quantities are <u>indicative only</u> and cannot be guaranteed. The annual requirement is estimated at 1000 km and this can consist of any of the different types listed in the Schedule.
- 1.5 Tenderers must indicate the price of each type of cable separately. Volume discounts must be indicated separately per volume specified.
- 1.6 Tenders will be adjudicated on technical compliance, local support, delivery, BEE, and price comparison. The "bulk order price" will be used for comparison. Price will not be the main criteria.
- 1.7 Transnet prefers that prices quoted must remain fixed for a period of 12 months after award of the contract. Thereafter, price escalation based on a proportion of imported and local content must be based on ROE and CPI is allowed and must be clearly stated. Failure to comply will result in disqualification, as it will be impossible to compare the bids of the Tenderers.
- 1.8 Transnet reserves the right to accept or reject any item (type of cable) or price offered and to enter into price negotiations before conclusion of an agreement.

- 2.2 Clause by clause statements of compliance must be submitted to this document as well as the specifications mentioned above. Failing this requirement will preclude a tender from consideration.
- 2.3 Where a clause calls for more information than a simple "yes" or "no", the Tenderer must submit an accompanying response bearing the relevant document name, the clause number, and the additional information.
- 2.4 Local support is a requirement for the supply of optical fibre cable. The Tenderer must have a staffed office permanently in the Republic of South Africa which qualified personnel to conduct quality tests and address any queries from Transnet with respect to the performance of their optical fibre cables. The name(s) and qualifications of such technical expert(s) must be provided.
- 2.5 The Tenderer must have local test facilities to conduct all the tests described in the above specifications. Failure to do so will result in the tests being conducted in a facility of Transnet's choice at the Tenderer's cost. Tenderers must state the location of their test site.

STANDARDS

3.1 The single mode optical fibre cable must comply with the requirements of the attached technical specifications and meet the latest relevant ITU and IEC recommendations and reports. In particular it must comply with ITU recommendations G.652D, G.655D and G.650 (test methods). The requirements of ISO/IEC standards 793-1 and 794-1 must also apply. The more stringent of these recommendations and attached technical specifications will apply.



3.2 As some cable drums could be stored for a considerable time for maintenance purposes, Tenderers must state what precautions will be taken to protect the cable drums against the ingress of water as well as resistance against insects and fungi. The drums must survive outdoor storage for at least 3 years.

QUALITY ASSURANCE AND FACTORY TESTING

- 4.1 The Tenderer must submit full details of his Quality Assurance Procedures during and after manufacture, that will ensure the OFC cable offered fully complies with the requirements of this enquiry and specifications.
- 4.2 Independently certified test records of specified materials and components and assembled cable parameters must be submitted to Transnet as requested. Regular batch tests of the mechanical characteristics of the cable must be performed.
- 4.3 The contractor must submit detailed optical and type test reports to Transnet, before any consignment of OFC is despatched.
- 4.4 Transnet reserves the right to call for any testing or inspection at any time during the duration of the supply contract.
- 4.5 Two 120-metre test lengths of 36-fibre cable of each type, exactly to specification, must be submitted to Transnet within 30 days from date of advertisement of this enquiry. Failure to do this will preclude a tender from consideration. Delivery must be affected to Transnet Technical Execution Depot, No.2 Industrie Road, Isando, Gauteng. The Tenderer must bear all costs in respect of this requirement.
- Two drums of single mode optical fibre, containing 4000 metres of fibre (G.652D and G.655D) each, exactly to that offered must also be delivered to Transnet within 30 days from date of advertisement of this enquiry. Failure to do this will preclude a tender from consideration. to the above address for testing and evaluation.

5. TRANSNET TESTING

- 5.1 The two test lengths of cable requested by Transnet will be used for optical and mechanical evaluations.
- 5.2 Optical tests will be carried out at both optical windows as well as the extended band to 1625 nm.
- 5.3 One of the tests will be the cascade splicing of all fibres in one test length of cable. The splice losses will be recorded and it is expected that 70% of the splice losses, after only one splice attempt, must be better than 0,1dB. Competent cable splicers with quality equipment will carry out this splicing.
- 5.4 Competent cable jointers will be tasked to perform several splices/joints on the optical fibre in order to assess the quality of the optical fibre pertaining to jointing.
- 5.5 Splicing compatibility with other manufacturer's fibres already in service with Transnet will be checked.
- 5.6 Mechanical testing will include fibre stress versus cable strain and other tensile tests.
- 5.7 Competent cable jointers will be tasked to evaluate the ease of stripping, cleaning and working with the physical cable.





6. ORDERS AND DELIVERY

- 6.1 Attached annexure A indicates the estimated types and quantities of OFC to be ordered by Transnet.
- 6.2 Orders will be placed via the Supply Chain Services Division of Transnet.
- 6.3 The tenderer must indicate timelines required for product delivery to site from placement of a technically correct order. A site shall be a major city or town in the Republic of South Africa.
- 6.4 Orders could be placed by Transnet as bulk orders, but staged deliveries must be scheduled by the supplier to coincide with delivery schedules provided by Transnet.
- 6.5 Tenderers must indicate the discounts that will apply on bulk orders. A bulk order will be considered as any order in excess of 100 km of a particular type of cable.



"**Confidential Information**" means Information relating to one party (the "Disclosing Party") and/or the business carried on or proposed or intended to be carried on by that party and which is made available for the purposes of the Proposal to the other party (the "Receiving Party") or its Agents by the Disclosing Party or its Agents or recorded in agreed minutes following oral disclosure and any other information otherwise made available by the Disclosing Party or its Agents to the Receiving Party or its Agents, whether before, on or after the date of this Agreement, and whether in writing or otherwise, including any information, analysis or specifications derived from, containing or reflecting such information but excluding information which:-

- (i) is publicly available at the time of its disclosure or becomes publicly available (other than as result of disclosure by the Receiving Party or any of its Agents contrary to the terms of this letter); or
- (ii) was lawfully in the possession of the Receiving Party or its Agents (as can be demonstrated by its written records or other reasonable evidence) free of any restriction as to its use or disclosure prior to its being so disclosed; or

2. Confidential Information

- 2.1 The Receiving Party will treat and keep all Confidential Information as secret and confidential and will not, without the Disclosing Party's written consent, directly or indirectly communicate or disclose (whether in writing or orally or in any other manner) Confidential Information to any other person other than in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- 2.2 The Receiving Party will only use the Confidential Information for the sole purpose of technical and commercial discussions between the parties in relation to the Proposal or for the subsequent performance of any contract between the parties in relation to the Proposal.
- 2.3 Notwithstanding clause 2.1, the Receiving Party may disclose Confidential Information:

10.1 Neither party may assign the benefit of this Agreement nor may any interest hereunder except with the prior written consent of the other, save that Transnet assign this Agreement at any time to any member of the Transnet Group.

- 10.2 No failure or delay in exercising any right, power or privilege under this Agreement will operate as a waiver of it, nor will any single or partial exercise of it preclude any further exercise or the exercise of any right, power or privilege under this Agreement or otherwise.
- 10.3 The provisions of this Agreement shall be severable in the event that any of its provisions are held by a court of competent jurisdiction or other applicable authority to be invalid, void or otherwise unenforceable, and the remaining provisions shall remain enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 10.4 This Agreement may only be modified by a written agreement duly signed by persons authorized on behalf of each party.
- 10.5 Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute the creation of a partnership, joint venture or agency between the parties.

This Agreement will be governed by, and construed in accordance with South African law and the parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the South African courts.



- 3) Where special permits are required, such as electrical switching, hot work permits, etc. the contractor shall obtain them from a person designated by Transnet Limited for this purpose, and all requirements of the contractor must rigidly comply with the permit.
- 4) The contractor shall conduct a risk assessment of the work to be performed by a competent person prior to the commencement of work, to identify risks and hazards that persons may be exposed to, analyse and evaluate identified hazards.

- 6) The Health and Safety Plan shall include the following:
 - 6.1 The safety management structure to be instituted with all appointments in terms of the Act and Regulations

- 13) In the event where the risk assessment reveals the risk relating to working from an elevated position the contractor shall cause the designation of a competent person, responsible for the preparation of a Fall Protection Plan.
- 14) The Fall Protection Plan shall include:
 - 14.1 A risk assessment of all work carried out from an elevated position
 - 14.2 Procedures and methods to address all the identified risks per location

14.3 Evaluation of employees physical and psychological fitness necessary to work at elevated position.

14.4 The training of employees working from an elevated position.

15) The contractor shall advise the * Health and Safety Section / Risk Manager/ Occupational Risk Manager of Transnet Limited of any hazardous situations which may arise from work being performed either by the contractor or his subcontractor.
