1 Responses to RFQ

Responses to this RFQ [**Quata ions**] must not include documents or reference relating to any other quotation or proposal. Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. The original signed BFQ will serve as the legal binding document and no copies will be accepted for evaluation purposes.

2 Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEE]

Trans et Nay endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it would therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will accordingly allow a "preference" to companies who provide a valid B-BBEE Verification Certificate. All procurement transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

2.1 B-BBEE Scorecard and Rating

As prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are to note the following:

- In this RFQ, Transnet will apply the 80/20 preference point system prescribed in the PPPFA if the lowest acceptable bid is greater than Thirty Thousand rand (R 30 000.00).
- Proposals will be evaluated on price which will be allocated 80 points and preference which will be allocated 20 points.
- The 80/20 preference point system applies where the acquisition of the Services will be less than R1 000 000.00. However, if the 80/20 preference point system is stipulated in this RFQ and all Bids received exceed R1 000 000.00, the RFQ will be cancelled.

In compliance with the Government Gazette No 34612, Notice No. 754 dated 23 September 2011, as from 1 October 2011 valid B-BBEE Verification Certificates must be issued by:

- (i) Verification Agencies accredited by the South African National Accreditation System [SANAS]; or
- (ii) Registered Auditors approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors [IRBA], in accordance with the approval granted by the Department of Trade and Industry.

Enterprises will be rated by such agencies based on the following:

- a) Large Enterprises [i.e. annual turnover greater than R35 million]:
 - Rating level based on all seven elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- b) **Qualifying Small Enterprises QSE** [i.e. annual turnover between R5 million and R35 million]:
 - Rating based on any four of the elements of the B-BPFF scared.
- c) **Exempted Micro Enterprises EME** [i.e. annual turn over less than R5 million]:

In accordance with B-BBEE Codes of Good Practic [Struement 000, Section 4], any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R 5 million of less qualifies as an EME.

- Automatic rating of B-BBEE Level 4 respective of race or ownership
- Black ownership greater than 50% or fack Women ownership greater than 50% automatically qualify as B-BBEE Level 3

Sufficient evidence to qualify as an EME would be a certificate (which may be in the form of a letter) from an audito or accounting officer or a certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS. The certificate must confirm the company's turnover, black ownership / black female ownership, problems at the salt sevel and validity date.

Responder are required to furnish proof of the above to Transnet. [i.e. a valid detailed scorecard as stipulated above in respect of Large Enterprises and QSEs, or a valid certificate in respect of ENES].

Transnet will accordingly allocate a maximum of **20 [twenty] points** to the Respondent's final based on an entity's B-BBEE scorecard rating.

N.B. Failure to submit a B-BBEE certificate, which is valid as at the Closing Date of this RFP, will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

A Supplier shall be obliged to adhere to the Standard Terms and Conditions for the Supply of Goods and Services to Transnet as expressed hereunder. Should the Respondent find any condition(s) unacceptable, it should indicate which condition(s) is/are unacceptable and offer an alternative(s). A Quotation submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

1 SOLE AGREEMENT

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, these terms [**Terms** and each **Term**] and **Transnet**'s purchase order(s) [**Order** or **Orders**] represent the only conditions upon which Transnet SO Ltd [**Transnet**] procures goods or services specified in the Order [collectively, the **Products**] from the person to whom the Order is addressed [**the Supplier**]. Transnet does not accept any other conditions which the Supplier may specify, unless otherwise agreed to by Transnet in writing. In the event of any is possistency between these Terms and any Order, these Terms shall take precedence.

2 CONFORMITY WITH ORDER

Products shall conform strictly with the Order. The Supplier shall not vary the quantities specified and/or the specification, if any, stipulated in the Order. Without the prior written consent of Transnet. The Supplier warrants that the Products shall be fit for their purpose and of satisfactory quality.

3 DELIVERY AND TITLE

- 3.1 The delivery dates and addresses are those in the Order. Time shall be of the essence in respect of the Supplier's obligations up or the Order.
- 3.2 The Supplier will not be excused for delay in delivery or performance except due to circumstances outside its control and then only subject to the Supplier having notified Transnet in writing on becoming aware of such circumstances. Transnet may terminate an Order, in whole or in part, without incurring any liability to the Supplier if such a delay becomes, in Transnet's absolute upinited significant.
- 3.3 Lisk of loss or damage to Products shall pass to Transnet on delivery, and title shall pass to Transnet when payment to the Supplier for the Products has been effected.
- 3.4 If on delivery, the Products do not conform to the Order, Transnet may reject the Products and the Supplier shall promptly rectify any defects or in Transnet's opinion, supply appropriate replacement Products at the Supplier's expense within the specified delivery times, without any liability due by Transnet. Products shall be subject to such testing and/or inspection as Transnet may consider necessary.

4 PRICE AND PAYMENT

4.1 Prices specified in an Order cannot be increased. Payment for the Products shall be made by Transnet against an original undisputed invoice(s) [a **Tax Invoice**], supporting documentation and

- month-end statement from the Supplier. Tax Invoices plus supporting documentation shall be posted to the address shown in the Order.
- 4.2 Payment of the Supplier's valid Tax Invoice(s) will be made by Transnet in the South African currency and on the terms stated in the Order, the standard payment terms being 30 [thirty] days from date of receipt by Transnet of a month-end statement, unless otherwise agreed to in writing. Transnet shall arrange for payment of such Tax Invoices and any pre-authorised additional expenses incurred, provided that the authorised expenses are supported by acceptable documentary proof of expenditure incurred [where this is available]. Any amounts due in terms of these Terms shall be paid to the Supplier, taking into account any deduction or set-off and bank charges.

5 PROPRIETARY RIGHTS LIABILITY

If any allegations should be made or any claim asserted against Transnet that ownership of, or any act or omission by Transnet in relation to Products or any written material provided to Transnet relating to any Products or pursuant to an Order being a violation or infringement of any third party's contractual, industrial, commercial or intellectual property rights including but not limited to any patent, registered design, design right, trade mark, copyright or sentise mark on any application thereof, the Supplier hereby indemnifies Transnet against and hold it hamble's from any and all losses, liabilities, costs, claims, damages and expenses [including any legal fees pansing directly or indirectly from such allegation or claim provided that this indemnity shall not apply where the allegation or claim arises solely as a result of the Supplier following a design or processoriging ted and furnished by Transnet. The Supplier shall either

- a) procure for Transnet the right to continue using the infringing Products; or
- b) modify or replace the Projects so that they become non-infringing,

provided that in both cases the Products shall continue to meet Transnet's requirements and any specifications stipulated in the Order. Should neither option be possible, the Supplier may remove, with Transnet's prior wheten consent, such Products and will pay to Transnet a sum equivalent to the purchase prior. If transnet refuses to give such consent, the Supplier shall have no liability in respect of any continued use of the infringing Products after Supplier's prior written request to remove the same.

PROPRIETARY INFORMATION

All information which Transnet has divulged or may divulge to the Supplier and any information relating to Transnet's business which may have come into the Supplier's possession whilst carrying out an Order, and the existence of the Order, shall be treated by the Supplier as confidential information and shall not, without Transnet's prior written consent, be disclosed to any third party, or be used or copied for any purposes other than to perform the Order. This clause does not apply to information which is public knowledge or available from other sources other than by breach of this Term. Upon request by Transnet, the Supplier shall return all materials issued pursuant to the Order and, pending this, shall protect Transnet's rights in any such materials. Such confidential information shall at all material times be the property of Transnet.

7 DEVELOPMENT WORK IN THE PRODUCTION OF PRODUCTS

If the production or provision of any Products involves research and/or development which is wholly or partly funded by Transnet, then all intellectual property or other rights as a result thereof shall be the property of Transnet on creation.

8 PUBLICITY

The Supplier shall not name Transnet or use its trademarks, service marks [whether registered or not] or Products in connection with any publicity without Transnet's prior written consent.

9 AFTER SALES SERVICE

The Supplier shall provide replacement parts necessary to ensure the uninterrupted operation of the Products supplied for the duration of the warranty period, from delivery of any particular item of the Products and if requested by Transnet shall make these parts available to a third party maintainer of Transnet's choice at the same price as if the parts had been supplied to a unintersect. The Supplier undertakes to provide a maintenance service for Products, should Transnet so request, on terms to be agreed. If the Order so indicates, the Supplier will provide a warranty service for the Products at a level to be agreed with Transnet.

10 TERMINATION OF ORDER

- Transnet may cancel an Order in whole or in part at any time upon at least 7 [seven] days' written notice to the Supplier, or when there is a change in control of the Supplier or the Supplier commits any serious breach or any repeated or continued material breach of its obligations under these Terms and/or Order or shall have been guilty of conduct tending to bring itself into disrepute, on written notice to the Supplier when such work on the Order shall stop.
- Transnet shall say the Supplier a fair and reasonable price for justified work in progress, where such price inflects only those costs not otherwise recoverable by the Supplier, at the time of termination, and the Supplier shall give Transnet full assistance to check the extent of such work progress. Payment of such price shall be in full and final satisfaction of any claims arising out of such termination and upon such payment the Supplier shall deliver to Transnet all work, including any materials, completed or in progress. The sum payable to the Supplier under this clause will not in any event exceed the total amount that would have been payable to the Supplier had the Order not been terminated.
- 10.3 In the event of termination the Supplier must submit all claims within 2 [two] months of termination after which time claims will only be met in what Transnet considers exceptional circumstances.
- 10.4 If the Products are not provided in accordance with an Order, the Order shall be deemed terminated and the Supplier shall compensate Transnet for any costs incurred in obtaining substitute Products or any damage caused due to the failure or delay in the delivery.

11 ACCESS

The Supplier shall be liable for the acts, omissions and defaults of its personnel or agents who, for the purposes of the Order, shall be treated as if they are the Supplier's employees. The Supplier shall ensure that any such personnel or agents, whilst on Transnet's premises, shall comply with Transnet's health and safety, security and system security rules and procedures as and where required.

12 WARRANTY

The Supplier warrants that it is competent to supply the Products in accordance with these Terms to the reasonable satisfaction of Transnet and that all Products delivered under the Order: (a) conform and comply in all relevant legislation, standards, directives and orders related to [inter alia] the supply, manufacture and use of the Products in force at the time of delivery, and to ally specifications referred to in the Order; (b) will not cause any deterioration in the functionality of any Transnet equipment; and (c) do not infringe any third party rights of any kind. The Supplier hereby incoming Transnet against all losses, liabilities, costs, claims, damages, expenses and awards of any kinds incomed or made against Transnet in connection with any breach of this warranty.

13 INSOLVENCY

If the Supplier shall have a receiver, manager, composition, liquidator or like person appointed over all or any part of its assets or if the Supplier composition with its creditors or passes a resolution for the writing up or administration of the Supplier, Transhet is at liberty to terminate the Order or Orders forthwith, or at its option, to seek performance by any such appointed person.

14 ASSIGNMENT

The Supplier shall not acting it obligations under an Order without Transnet's prior written consent, which consent shall not be threasonably withheld or delayed.

15 NOTICES

Notices under these Terms shall be delivered by hand to the relevant addresses of the parties in the Order or pack by served by facsimile or by email, in which event notice shall be deemed served on acknowledgement of receipt by the recipient.

6 LW

Orders shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with South African law and any disputes arising herein shall be subject to South African arbitration under the rules of the Arbitration Foundation of South Africa, which rules are deemed incorporated by reference in this clause. The reference to arbitration shall not prevent Transnet referring the matter to any South African courts, having jurisdiction, to which the Supplier hereby irrevocably submits but without prejudice to Transnet's right to take proceedings against the Supplier in other jurisdictions and/or obtaining interim relief on an urgent basis from a court of competent jurisdiction pending the decision in other courts or from instituting in any court of competent jurisdiction any proceedings for an interdict or any other injunctive relief. If the Supplier does not have a registered office in the South Africa it will at all times maintain an agent for service of process in South Africa and shall give Transnet the name and address of such agent as such may be amended, in writing, from time to time.

17 GENERAL

Completion or termination of an Order shall be without prejudice to any Term herein which by its nature would be deemed to continue after completion or termination, including but not limited to clauses 5, 6, 7, 8 and 12. Headings are included herein for convenience only. If any Term herein be held illegal or unenforceable, the validity or enforceability of the remaining Terms shall not be affected. No failure or delay by Transnet to enforce any rights under these Terms will operate as a waiver thereof by Transnet. All rights and remedies available to either party under these Terms shall be in addition to, not to the exclusion of, rights otherwise available at law.

18 COUNTERPARTS

These Terms and conditions may be signed in any number of counterparts. If of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Any party may enter into this agreement by signing any such counterpart.

SPECIFICATION TO FIT/INSTALL NEW 220KV AND 25KV TRANSFORMER BUSHINGS

BACKGROUND

Transnet Freight Rail requires the installation/fitting of free issued transformer bushings to their substations i.e. Brak Rivier, Woodlands and Verby between Port Elizabeth and Alicedale in the Eastern Cape.

SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

Sites where the bushings are to be fitted:

Between Port Elizabeth and Alicedale

- 1. Brak Rivier (4 X 220Kv and 4 X 25Kv bushings)
- 2. Woodlands (2 X 220Kv and 2 X 25Kv bushings)
- 3. Verby (2 X 220Kv and 2 X 25Kv bushings)

Note:

All safety files, Letters of appointments and all related safety administration to be adhered to must be furnished before work can proceed.

Transnet will supply and deliver the 220kv and 52kv Bushings to site and Contractor will work under cover of TFR work permit in the Substation yard.

Work can only take place in dry weather condition. Programme to be planned in conjunction with weather forecast 5days before work commencement.

Installation of 220kv Toshiba Transformer Bushings

- 1. Before any work, transformer to be meggered and readings must be ogged
- 2. Replace the bushings using approved rigging methods or processes and all equipment which requires any level of competence must be operated by authorised person.
- 3. The following to be supplied by contactor to drain then sformer oil to the required level of approximately 9000 litres:
 - Oil reservoir
 - Standby plant
 - Oil pump
 - All necessary tools and equipment to perform the entire task.
- 4. Transformer oil to be fill red once the bushings are fitted and contractor to supply filtering plant with 3 phase standby supply of approximately 100Amps per phase. Note: total of 3 passes as per TFR specifications
- 5. All gaskets in the bushings and inspection covers (which need to be opened) to be supplied and replaced by contractor and should be of the same thickness as the original (type 72 packing)
- 6. A juidance of fitting method is attached (220Kv Bushing weight is approximately 650kg and 52 Kv (shing is approximately 90kg) and only approved slings and necessary approved equipment should be used for the right job.
- 7. Crane with enough lifting clearance to be supplied by contractor (total height to be lifted approximately 14m including crane jib height)
- 8. Provision by contractor to replace any rusted/broken studs or nuts and bolts must be with original size and type of materials.
- 9. All aspects of the work to be left in perfect working order (no oil leaks, oil spills to be clean up).
- 10. All overhead conductors, flying busbar, earths ETC which may be removed by contractor must be placed back in the same working order.
- 11. Transformer to be meggered on the completion of the work.

INSURANCE

The contractor will arrange insurance for all his plant and equipment utilized on site. The contractor will provide liability insurance to cover any incident or claim that may arises during the contract execution period.

PENALTIES

The contractor will provide a safety file with all relevant documents namely; appointment letters, written safe working statement, medical certificates, good standing with the compensation commissioner, appointment of competent supervisors, site instruction book, site dairy, fall projection plan etc. within 2 weeks of appointment and ensure that their site diary is present at all times.

- Failure to provide the mentioned documentation will automatically led to the cancellation of the contract.
- The following penalties will apply or part thereof or any delays, i.e. R500 per day up to a maximum of 12% of the contract amount
