8. BROAD-BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT ("BBBEE")

TRANSNET fully endorses and supports the South African Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programmed and it is strongly of the opinion that all business enterprises have an equal obligation to redress the imbalances of the past. TRANSNET would therefore prefer to do business with business enterprises who share these same values and who are prepared to contribute to meaningful BBBEE initiatives (including and not limited to enterprise development, subcontracting and Joint Ventures) as part of their tender response.

Transnet would accordingly allow a "preference" in accordance with the 10% preference system, as per the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2000 (as amended) to companies who provide a BBBEE accreditation Certificate. All procurement and disposal transactions in excess of R30000 will be evaluated accordingly. All transactions below R 30,000 will as far as possible be earmarked for EME's.

TRANSNET consequently urges Respondents (Large enterprises and QSE's – see below) to have themselves duly accredited by any one of the Accreditation Agencies **approved** by SANAS (South African National Accreditation System, under the auspices of the DTI).

In terms of Government Gazette No. 32467, Notice No. 810 dated 31 July 2009, as from 1 February 2010 only BBBEE certificates issued by Accredited Verification Agencies of Verification Agencies that are in possession of a valid pre-assessment letter from South African National Accreditation System will be valid.

However accreditation certificates issued by non-accredited verification agencies before 01 February 2010 and which are still within their one (1) year validity period will still be acceptable, until their expiry date provided that the accreditation was done in accordance with the latest codes (i.e. those promulgated on 9 February 2007).

BBBEE Accreditation Certificates issued after the published date i.e. 01 February 2010, by a Verification Agency not approved by SANAS, will NOT be acceptable as from 01 February 2010.

Enterprises will be rated by such Accreditation Agencies based on the following:

- (a) <u>Large Enterprises (i.e. annual turnover >R35 million):</u>
 - > Rating level based on all 7 (seven) elements of the BBBEE scorecard
 - Enterprises to provide BBBEE certificate and detailed scorecard (to be renewed annually)
- (b) Qualifying Small Enterprises QSE (i.e. annual turnover >R5 million but <R35 million):
 - Rating based on any 4 (four) of the elements of the BBBEE scorecard
 - > Enterprises to provide BBBEE certificate and detailed scorecard (to be renewed annually)
- (c) <u>Exempted Micro Enterprises EME (i.e. annual turnover <R5m are exempted from being rated or verified)</u>:
 - Automatic BBBEE Level 4 rating, irrespective of race ownership, i.e. 100% BBBEE recognition



- ➤ Black ownership >50% or Black Women ownership >30% automatically qualify as Level 3 BBBEE rating, i.e. 110% BBBEE recognition
- ➤ EME's should provide documentary proof of annual turnover (i.e. audited financials) plus proof of Black ownership if Black ownership >50% or Black Women ownership >30% (to be renewed annually) from their Auditors / Accounting Officers

In addition to the above, Respondents who wish to enter into a Joint Venture (JV) or subcontract portions of the contract to BBBEE companies must state in their Tenders / Proposals the percentage of the total contract value which would be allocated to such BBBEE companies, should they be successful in being awarded any business. A rating certificate in respect of such BBBEE JV-partners and/or sub-contractors, as well as a breakdown of the distribution of the aforementioned percentage allocation must also be furnished with the tender response to enable Transnet to evaluate / adjudicate on all tenders received on a fair basis.

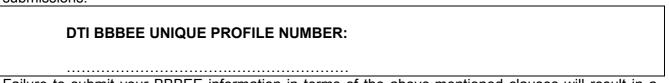

1. SCOPE OF WORK

2. **AREA OF OPERATIONS**

The area of operations shall be as follows: -

3. WORKING HOURS

The normal working hours for this contract shall be between 07:00 and 17:00, with a half hour break between 12:00 and 12:30 daily.

4. **ESCALATION**

All increases in costs from whatsoever cause shall be at the Contractor's risk and for his account.

5. VALUE ADDED TAX

Value Added Tax at the ruling percentage shall be paid as per Contractors invoice.

6. **INSURANCE**

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to arrange for any insurance cover or additional insurance cover for his machine, facilities and staff.



Transnet Freight Rail will not consider a claim for loss, death, injury or damage from any cause whatsoever.

7. ACCOMMODATION

No accommodation of any description will be provided by Transnet Freight Rail for the Contractor's use. Accommodation and transportation to and from work sites is for the contractors account.

8. **FUEL**

The Contractor will be responsible for refuelling plant in question

9. MOVEMENT OF PLANT

Movement to and from site shall be as directed by Transnet Freight Rail and will be arranged by Transnet Freight Rail.

10. SERVICING AND MAINTENANCE

The Contractor shall provide all material, tools and equipment necessary for the servicing and maintenance of his plant and shall carry out the servicing and maintenance at his own expense and in his own time.

11. DURATION OF CONTRACT

The contract period will be 12 **months** from the date that the Contractor is notified of the acceptance of his tender

the contract will have a limiting value of **as stated by Transnet** and the contract period will be such that the value is not exceeded.

12. SITE DOCUMENTATION

The Contractor shall supply a duplicate carbon copy book with detachable numbered sheets. This logbook must stay with the Contractor's plant at all times. A daily log of hours worked and breakdowns shall be kept, each day on a separate sheet. The Contractor must ensure that the logsheets are signed and date stamped by the Site Supervisor or Engineer before submitting such documentation for payment.

13. BASIS FOR PROVISION OF PLANT

The plant shall be provided by the Contractor on an "as and when required" basis. Transnet Freight Rail will, wherever possible, endeavour to give at least one days notice of intent. Transnet Freight Rail reserves the right to terminate the activities of the plant, for whatsoever reason, on the understanding that one full days notice be given.

13.1 No subcontracting of plant and equipment.

14. CANCELLATION OR REMOVAL OF THE PLANT FROM SITE

If, in the opinion of Transnet Freight Rail, the operator or the output of the plant is unsatisfactory, Transnet Freight Rail reserves the right to:-

- (i) cancel the contract
- (ii) order the removal of the operator
- (iii) order the removal, temporarily or permanently, of the particular item of plant, or its replacement.



15. MECHANICAL CONDITION

Transnet Freight Rail reserves the right to inspect all plant offered as well as the maintenance infrastructure offered prior to the awarding of the contract. All plant offered should be either (1) not older than 5 years, or (2) have been reconditioned within the last 5 years.

* Copies of vehicle registration documents are to accompany tender documents (Logbook, COF certificate).

16. **STANDING TIME**

When the Contractor has been ordered to work, and if the plant is available for work but is not working due to a requirement, act or omission on the part of Transnet Freight Rail or nay other Contractor working for Transnet Freight Rail, the Contractor will be paid standing time:

- (i) only for time falling within the hours of duty specified;
- (ii) only when the plant is in full working order.

The time claimed as standing time must be certified by an authorised representative of Transnet Freight Rail.

17. CERTIFICATE OF ACQUAINTANCE WITH CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

No tender will be accepted unless the Contractor certifies the Certificate of Acquaintance with Contract Documents.

18. **MEASUREMENT**

The unit of measurement will be the hour or part thereof.



19. **PAYMENT**

- 19.1 Payment will only be made for those items mentioned in the Schedule of Prices, after being certified by the Site Supervisor.
- 19.2 Payment will be made per hour or part thereof that the plant is in the possession of Transnet Freight Rail, provided that the plant is in a fully operational condition.
- 19.3 The rates quoted in the Schedule of Prices shall be inclusive of all costs in the supply and maintenance in a fully operational condition of the plant.
- 19.4 Payment will be strictly 30 days from date of invoice.
- 19.5 Time invoiced will be from commencement of work at the work site until stoppage of work at the work site.

20. PENALTY

A penalty of R350.00 per day (Incident for poor performance or non compliance) will be levied to the contractor.

Should the contractor not be able to respond to Transnet Freight Rail's request or as per this tender document, the contractor will be liable for the difference in cost between the tendered price and the next tenderer's price.

21. **SECURITY**

Security is to be provided by the contractor to safe guard his equipment when attached to Transnet Freight Rail.

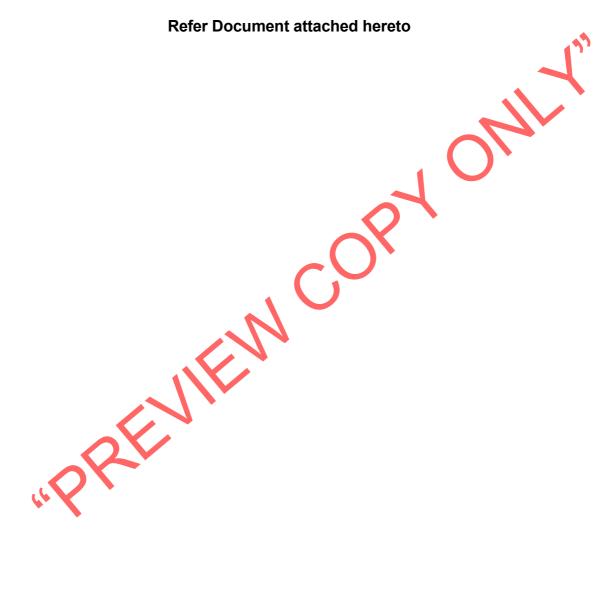

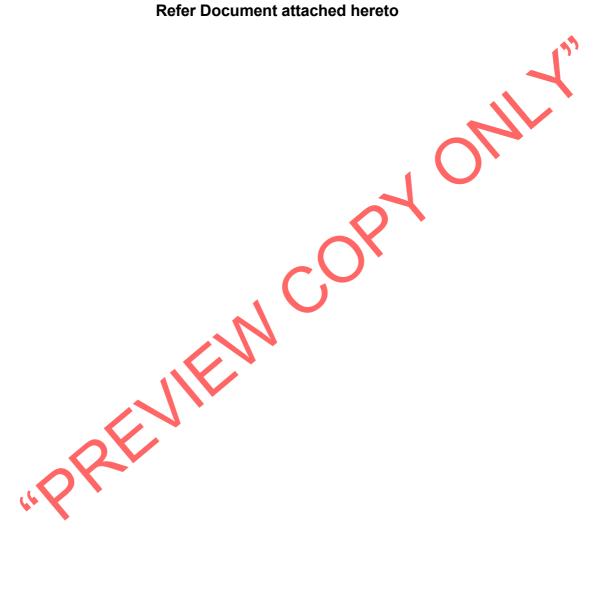

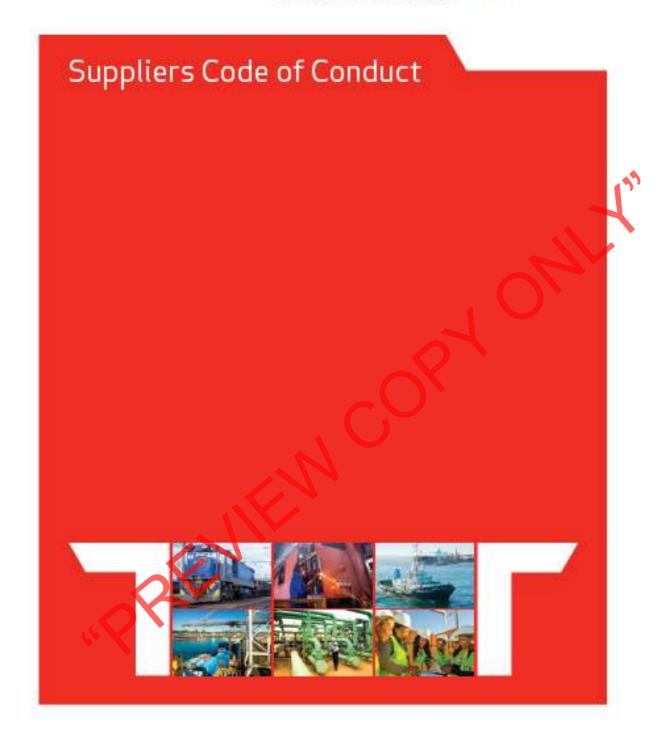
