### 1 Responses to RFQ

Responses to this RFQ [**Quotations**] must not include a surrents or reference relating to any other quotation or proposal. Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter.

### 2 Broad-Based Black Economic Empowermed [B-BBEE]

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it would therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will accordingly allow a "preference" to companies who provide a valid B-BBEE Verification Certificate. All programment transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

### 2.1 B-BBEE Score and Rating

As prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are to note that the following preference point system is policable to all bids:

- the 80/20 system for requirements with a Rand value of up to R1 000 000 (all applicable taxes included).
- Bidders are to note that if the 80/20 preference point system is stipulated in this RFP and all Bids received exceed R1 000 000.00, the RFP must be cancelled.

The value of this bid is estimated to be below R1000 000 (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

When Transnet invites prospective suppliers to submit Proposals for its various expenditure programmes, it requires Respondents to have their B-BBEE status verified in compliance with the Codes of Good Practice issued in terms of the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Act No. 53 of 2003.

The Department of Trade and Industry recently revised the Codes of Good Practice on 11 October 2013 [Government Gazette No. 36928]. The Revised Codes will replace the Black Economic Empowerment Codes of Good Practice issued on 9 February 2007. The Revised Codes provide for

a one year transitional period starting 11 October 2013. During the transitional period, companies may elect to be measured in terms of the Revised Codes or the 2007 version of the Codes. After the first year of the implementation of the Revised Codes, B-BBEE compliance will be measured in terms of the Revised Codes without any discretion. Companies which are governed by Sector-specific Codes will be measured in terms of those Sector Codes.

As such, Transnet will accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes. Transnet will also continue to accept B-BBEE certificates issued in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes provided it was issued before 10 October 2014. Thereafter, Transnet will only accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes.

Respondents are required to complete Annexure A [the B-BBEE Preference Point Claim Form] and submit it together with proof of their B-BBEE Status as stipulated in the Claim Form in order to obtain preference points for their B-BBEE status.

Note: Failure to submit a valid and original B-BBEs certificate or a certified copy thereof at the Closing Date of this RFQ will result head or serve of zero being allocated for B-BBES.

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### **DEFINITIONS**

Where the following words or phrases are used in this Agreement, such words or phrases shall have the meaning assigned thereto in this clause, except where the context clearly requires otherwise:

Bid shall mean a Respondent's tendered response / proposal to a Transnet RFP or RFQ;

Bid Document(s) shall mean a reference to a Request for Proposal or Request for Quotation;

Day shall mean any day other than a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday;

Respondent(s) shall mean a respondent/bidder to a Bid Document;

RFP shall mean Request for Proposal;

RFQ shall mean Request for Quotation;

RFX shall mean RFP or RFQ, as the case may be;

Services shall mean the services required by Transnet as specified in its Ria Scument;

Service Provider shall mean the successful Respondent;

**Tax Invoice** shall mean the document as required by Section 20 of the Value-Added Tax Act, 89 of 1991, as may be amended from time to time;

Transnet shall mean Transnet SOC Ltd, a State wind Conpany; and

**VAT** shall mean Value-Added Tax in terms or the Value-Added Tax Act, 89 of 1991, as may be amended from time to time.

### **GENERAL**

All Bid Documents and subsequent tentracts and orders shall be subject to the following general conditions as laid down by Transner and treate be strictly adhered to by any Respondent to this RFX.

### SUBMISSION OF BID DOUMLE IS

A Bid, which shall hereinafter include reference to an RFP or RFQ, shall be submitted to Transnet no later that the closing date and time specified in accordance with the directions issued in the Bid Documents. Late Bids will not be considered.

oids shall be delivered in a sealed envelope in accordance with the instructions indicated in the Bid Documents with the Bid number and subject marked on the front of the envelope.

The Respondent's return address must be stated on the reverse side of the sealed envelope.

### **USE OF BID FORMS**

Where special forms are issued by Transnet for the submission of Bids, Respondents are required to submit their Bids by completion of the appropriate sections on such official forms and not in other forms or documents bearing their own terms and conditions of contract. Non-compliance with this condition may result in the rejection of a Bid.

Respondents must note that the original Bid forms must be completed for submission and not a reprocessed copy thereof.

Only if insufficient space has been allocated for a particular response may a Respondent submit additional information under separate cover using its company's letterhead. This must be duly cross-referenced in the RFX.

#### **BID FEES**

A non-refundable fee may be charged for Bid Documents, depending on the administrative cost of preparing and issuing such Bid Documents.

Only Respondents that have paid the Bid fee and provided proof of payment when submitting their Bid will be considered.

### **VALIDITY PERIOD**

Respondents must hold their Bid valid for acceptance by Transnet at any time within the requested validity period after the closing date of the RFX.

Respondents may be requested to extend their validity period for a specified additional period. In such instances, Respondents will not be allowed to change any aspect of their Bid, unless they are able to demonstrate that the proposed change(s) is as a direct and unavoidable consequence of Transnet's extension of the validity period.

### SITE VISIT / BRIEFING SESSION

Respondents may be requested to attend (i) a site visit where it is considered necessary to view the site prior to the preparation of Bids, or (ii) an RFX briefing session when Transnet deems it necessary to provide Respondents with additional information relevant to the compilation of their Bids. When such visits or sessions are indicated as compulsory in the big Document, Respondents are obliged to attend these meetings as failure to do so will result in their disposalification.

### CLARIFICATION BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE

Should clarification be required on any aspect of the RFX before the closing date, the Respondent must direct such queries to the control person identified in the Bid Document.

### COMMUNICATION AFTER THE LOSING DATE

has been included as a company or person prohibited from doing business with the public sector on National Treasury's database of Restricted Suppliers or Register of Bid Defaulters; then a Bid from any such Respondent shall be disqualified and the person, enterprise or company [including any directors] shall, subject to clause 0 below, be disqualified from bidding for any Transnet business through its "blacklisting" process.



Any person or enterprise or company against whom a decision to blacklist has been taken, may make representations to the Chief Financial Officer of Transnet SOC Ltd, whose decision shall be final.

Any disqualification [**Blacklisting**] imposed upon any person or enterprise or company, may also apply to any other enterprise under the same or different names of disqualified persons or enterprise or company [or associates thereof] and may also be applied to any agent or employee of the person or enterprise or company concerned.

### **CURRENCY**

All monetary amounts referred to in a Bid response must be in Rand, the currency of the Republic of South Africa [ZAR], save to the extent specifically permitted in the RFX.

### PRICES SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION

Prices which are quoted subject to confirmation will not be considered.

Firm prices quoted for the duration of any resulting order and/or contract will receive precedence over prices which are subject to fluctuation if this is in Transnet's best interests.

### ALTERATIONS MADE BY THE RESPONDED TO BID PRICES

All alterations made by the Respondent to its Bid price(s) prior to the submission of its Bid Documents must be done by deleting the incorrect figures and words where required and by inserting the correct figures and words against the items concerned. All such alterations must be initialled by the person who signs the Bid Documents. Failure to observe this requirement may result in the particular item(s) concerned being excluded in the matter of the award of the business.

### EXCHANGE AND REMINIONCE

The Remondent should note that where the whole or a portion of the contract or order value is to be remitted overseas, Transnet shall, if requested to do so by the Service Provider, effect payment overseas directly to the foreign principal of such percentage of the contract or order value as may be stipulated by the Respondent in its Bid Documents.

It is Transnet's preference to enter into Rand-based agreements. The South African Reserve Bank's approval is required before any foreign currency payments can be made to or on behalf of Respondents.

Transnet will not recognise any claim for adjustment of the order and/or contract price if the increase in price arises after the date on which agreement on an overall Rand contract has been reached.

16.6 Transnet reserves the right to request a pro-forma invoice/tax invoice in order to ensure compliance with the contract and Value-Added Tax Act no. 89 of 1991 [VAT Act].



### **ACCEPTANCE OF BID**

Transnet does not bind itself to accept the lowest priced or any Bid.

Transnet reserves the right to accept any Bid in whole or in part.

Upon the acceptance of a Bid by Transnet, the parties shall be bound by these General Bid Conditions and any contractual terms and/or any schedule of "Special Conditions" or otherwise which form part of the Bid Documents.

Where the Respondent has been informed by Transnet per fax message or email of the acceptance of its Bid, the acknowledgement of receipt transmitted shall be regarded as proof or elivery to the Respondent.

### NOTICE TO UNSUCCESSFUL RESPONDENTS

Unsuccessful Respondents shall be advised in writing that their hids have not been accepted as soon as possible after the closing date of the Bid. On award of busines to the successful Respondent all unsuccessful Respondents shall be informed of the name of the successful Respondent and of the reason as to why their Bids have not been successful.

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

The Service Provider shall adhere to the Tehns and Conditions of Contract issued with the Bid Documents, together with any schedule of "Special Conditions" or otherwise which form part of the Bid Documents.

Should the Respondent and any conditions unacceptable, it should indicate which conditions are unacceptable and order amendments/ alternatives by written submission on its company letterhead.

Any such submission shall be subject to review by Transnet's Legal Counsel who shall determine whether the proposed amendments/ alternative(s) are acceptable or otherwise, as the case may be.

### CONTRACT POCUMENTS

Should Transnet inform the Respondent that a formal contract will be signed, the abovementioned documents together with the Respondent's Bid response [and, if any, its covering letter and any subsequent exchange of correspondence] as well as Transnet's Letter of Acceptance/Intent, shall constitute a binding contract until the final contract is signed.

### LAW GOVERNING CONTRACT

### **IDENTIFICATION**

### Copyright

Copyright in plans, drawings, diagrams, specifications and documents compiled by the Service Provider for the purpose of contract work shall be governed by the *Intellectual Property Rights* section in the Terms and Conditions of Contract.

### BIDS BY OR ON BEHALF OF FOREIGN RESPONDENTS

- Bids submitted by foreign principals may be forwarded directly by the principals or by its South African representative or agent to the Secretary of the Acquisition Council of a designated official of Transnet according to whichever officer is specified in the Bid Doc ments.
- In the case of a representative or agent, written proof must the submitted to the effect that such representative or agent has been duly authorised to act in that capacity by the principal. Failure to submit such authorisation by the representative or agent shall disqualify the Bid.
- When legally authorised to prepare and submit Bids on b half of their principals not domiciled in the Republic of South Africa, representatives or agents and contaile the Bids in the names of such principals and sign them on behalf of the latter.

#### THIS AGREEMENT is made between

**Transnet SOC Ltd [Transnet]** [Registration No. 1990/000900/30] whose registered office is at 49<sup>th</sup> Floor, Carlton Centre, 150 Commissioner Street, Johannesburg 2001,

### and

### the Company as indicated in the RFP bid response hereto

### **WHEREAS**

Transnet and the Company wish to exchange Information [as defined below] and it is envisaged that each party may from time to time receive Information relating to the other in Napeet hereof. In consideration of each party making available to the other such Information, the partie jointly agree that any dealings between them shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement which themselves will be subject to the parameters of the Bid Document.

### IT IS HEREBY AGREED

### 1. INTERPRETATION

In this Agreement:

- 1.1 **Agents** mean directors, ifficers, employees, agents, professional advisers, contractors or subcontractors, or any Sroup member;
- 1.2 **Bid or Bid Polyment** means Transnet's Request for Information [RFI] Request for Proposal [RFP] or Request for Quotation [RFQ], as the case may be;
- 1.3 **Corride till Information** means any information or other data relating to one party [the Disclosing Party] and/or the business carried on or proposed or intended to be carried on by that party and which is made available for the purposes of the Bid to the other party [the Receiving Party] it its Agents by the Disclosing Party or its Agents or recorded in agreed minutes following oral disclosure and any other information otherwise made available by the Disclosing Party or its Agents to the Receiving Party or its Agents, whether before, on or after the date of this Agreement, and whether in writing or otherwise, including any information, analysis or specifications derived from, containing or reflecting such information but excluding information which:
  - a) is publicly available at the time of its disclosure or becomes publicly available [other than
    as a result of disclosure by the Receiving Party or any of its Agents contrary to the terms of
    this Agreement]; or
  - b) was lawfully in the possession of the Receiving Party or its Agents [as can be demonstrated by its written records or other reasonable evidence] free of any restriction as to its use or disclosure prior to its being so disclosed; or
  - c) following such disclosure, becomes available to the Receiving Party or its Agents [as can be demonstrated by its written records or other reasonable evidence] from a source other than the Disclosing Party or its Agents, which source is not bound by any duty of



confidentiality owed, directly or indirectly, to the Disclosing Party in relation to such information;

- 1.4 **Group** means any subsidiary, any holding company and any subsidiary of any holding company of either party; and
- **Information** means all information in whatever form including, without limitation, any information relating to systems, operations, plans, intentions, market opportunities, know-how, trade secrets and business affairs whether in writing, conveyed orally or by machine-readable medium.

### 2. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

- All Confidential Information given by one party to this Agreement [the Lisclosing Party] to the other party [the Receiving Party] will be treated by the Receiving Party as secret and confidential and will not, without the Disclosing Party's written consent, directly as indirectly communicate or disclose [whether in writing or orally or in any other manner] Confidential Information to any other person other than in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- The Receiving Party will only use the Confidential Information for the sole purpose of technical and commercial discussions between the parties in relation to the Bid or for the subsequent performance of any contract between the parties in relation to the Bid.
- 2.3 Notwithstanding clause 2.1 above, the Receiving Party may disclose Confidential Information:
  - a) to those of its Agenta who strictly need to know the Confidential Information for the sole purpose set out in cause 72 above, provided that the Receiving Party shall ensure that such Agents are made aware prior to the disclosure of any part of the Confidential Information that the same is confidential and that they owe a duty of confidence to the Disclosing Party. The Receiving Party shall at all times remain liable for any actions of such Agents that would constitute a breach of this Agreement; or
  - b) to the extent required by law or the rules of any applicable regulatory authority, subject to clause 2.4 below.
- 2.4 In the event that the Receiving Party is required to disclose any Confidential Information in accordance with clause 2.3 b) above, it shall promptly notify the Disclosing Party and cooperate with the Disclosing Party regarding the form, nature, content and purpose of such disclosure or any action which the Disclosing Party may reasonably take to challenge the validity of such requirement.
- In the event that any Confidential Information shall be copied, disclosed or used otherwise than as permitted under this Agreement then, upon becoming aware of the same, without prejudice to any rights or remedies of the Disclosing Party, the Receiving Party shall as soon as practicable notify the Disclosing Party of such event and if requested take such steps [including the institution of legal proceedings] as shall be necessary to remedy [if capable of remedy] the default and/or to prevent further unauthorised copying, disclosure or use.
- 2.6 All Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Disclosing Party and its disclosure shall not confer on the Receiving Party any rights, including intellectual property rights over the Confidential Information whatsoever, beyond those contained in this Agreement.



### 3. RECORDS AND RETURN OF INFORMATION

- 3.1 The Receiving Party agrees to ensure proper and secure storage of all Information and any copies thereof.
- 3.2 The Receiving Party shall keep a written record, to be supplied to the Disclosing Party upon request, of the Confidential Information provided and any copies made thereof and, so far as is reasonably practicable, of the location of such Confidential Information and any copies thereof.
- 3.3 The Company shall, within 7 [seven] days of receipt of a written demand from Transnet:
  - (i) return all written Confidential Information [including all copies]; and
  - (ii) expunge or destroy any Confidential Information from any computer, word processor or other device whatsoever into which it was copied, read or programmed by the Company or on its behalf.
- 3.4 The Company shall on request supply a certificate signature director as to its full compliance with the requirements of clause 3.3 b) above.

### 4. ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 4.1 Neither party will make or permit to be made any announcement or disclosure of its prospective interest in the Bid without the prior written consent of the other party.
- 4.2 Neither party shall make use of the other party's name or any information acquired through its dealings with the other party to publicity or marketing purposes without the prior written consent of the other party.

### 5. DURATION

The obligations of each party and its Agents under this Agreement shall survive the termination of any discussions or regolations between the parties regarding the Bid and continue thereafter for a period of 5 [five] ears.

### 6. PRINCPAL

8.2 The Receiving Party warrants that it and its Agents have the appropriate technical and organisational measures in place against unauthorised or unlawful processing of data relating to the Bid and against accidental loss or destruction of, or damage to such data held or processed by them.

### 9. GENERAL
