1 Responses to RFQ

Responses to this RFQ [**Quotations**] must not include documents or reference relating to any other quotation or proposal. Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter.

2 Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEK]

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it would therefore prefer to do tusiness with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will accordingly allow a "preference" to companies who provide a valid B-BBEE Verification Certificate. All procurement transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

2.1 B-BBEE Scorecard and Rating

As prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are to note that the following preference point system is applicable to all birs:

- 4h 80/20 system for requirements with a Rand value of up to R1 000 000 (all applicable taxes included).
- Bidders are to note that if the 80/20 preference point system is stipulated in this RFP and all Bids received exceed R1 000 000.00, the RFP must be cancelled.

The value of this bid is estimated to be below R1000 000 (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

When Transnet invites prospective suppliers to submit Proposals for its various expenditure programmes, it requires Respondents to have their B-BBEE status verified in compliance with the Codes of Good Practice issued in terms of the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment Act No. 53 of 2003.

The Department of Trade and Industry recently revised the Codes of Good Practice on 11 October 2013 [Government Gazette No. 36928]. The Revised Codes will replace the Black Economic Empowerment Codes of Good Practice issued on 9 February 2007. The Revised Codes provide for a one year transitional period starting 11 October 2013. During the transitional period, companies may elect to be measured in terms of the Revised Codes or the 2007 version of the Codes. After

the first year of the implementation of the Revised Codes, B-BBEE compliance will be measured in terms of the Revised Codes without any discretion. Companies which are governed by Sector-specific Codes will be measured in terms of those Sector Codes.

As such, Transnet will accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes. Transnet will also continue to accept B-BBEE certificates issued in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes provided it was issued before 10 October 2014. Thereafter, Transnet will only accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes.

Respondents are required to complete Annexure A [the B-BBEE Preference Point Claim Form] and submit it together with proof of their B-BBEE Status as stipulated in the Claim Form in order to obtain preference points for their B-BBEE status.

Note: Failure to submit a valid and original B-BBEE certificate or a certified copy thereof at the Closing Date of this RFQ will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

ANNEXURE A: B-BBEE PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORM

This preference form contains general information and serves as a claim for preference points for Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEE] Status Level of Contribution.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 A total of 20 preference points shall be awarded for B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.
- Failure on the part of a Bidder to fill in and/or to sign this 10mm and submit a B-BBEE Verification 1.2 Certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by the South African Accreditation System [SANAS] or a Registered Auditor approved by the Dependent Regulatory Board of Auditors [IRBA] or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation Act [CCA] together with the bid will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution are not claimed.
- Transnet reserves the right to require of a Bidder, either before a Bid is adjudicated or at any time 1.3 subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by Transnet.

2. **GENERAL DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1 "all applicable **ixes**" include value-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;
- 2.2 "B-BBEE" means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- 2.3 "B-BBEE status of contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- 2.4 "Bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by Transnet for the provision of goods, works or services;
- "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic 2.5 Empowerment Act, 2003 [Act No. 53 of 2003];
- "comparative price" means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional 2.6 discounts that can utilised have been taken into consideration;
- 2.7 "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skills and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a

contract;

- 2.8 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by Transnet;
- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 [five] million or less as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R10 [ten] million or less as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928;
- 2.10 "firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs and excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.11 "functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices.
- 2.13 "person" includes reference to a juristic person;
- 2.14 "QSE" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue between R5 [five] million and R35 [thirty five] million as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of between R10 [ten] million and R50 [fifty] million as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928
- 2.15 "**rand value**" means the lotal estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid in utacions, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- 2.16 "subcontract" means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- 2.17 "total revenue" bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Empowerment Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;
- 2.18 **"trust"** means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or bequeathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and
- "**trustee**" means any person, including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to be administered for the benefit of another person.

3. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

- 3.1 The Bidder obtaining the highest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 of the RFP will be awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to another bidder.
- 3.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking

- into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.
- 3.3 Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.
- 3.4 In the event of equal points scored, the Bid will be awarded to the Bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Bid will be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 3.6 Should two or more Bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

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POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION 4.

In terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to a Bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the 2007 letson of the Codes of Good Practice must 4.2 submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
- Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 4.3 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928 are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less and the entity's Level of Rack ownership.
- 4.4 Viversion of the Codes of Good Practice, Bidders other than EMEs must submit In terms of the their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.5 In terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928, Bidders who qualify as QSEs are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R50 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership. Large enterprises must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal 4.6 entity, provided that the entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.
- A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an 4.7 unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.

- 4.8 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 4.9 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Bidder qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- 4.10 A person awarded a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- 4.11 Bidders are to note that in terms of paragraph 2.6 of Statement 000 of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928, any representation made by an entity about its B-BBEE compliance must be supported by suitable evidence or documentation. As such, Transnet reserves the right to request such evidence or documentation from Bidders in order to verify any B-BREF recognition claimed.

1. Rehabilitation of Locomotive refuelling stations No 1, 2&3

The capacity of the refuelling station has been reduced significantly with refuelling station No1 been decommissioned and refuelling station No. 2 & 3 throughput has dropped considerable from approximate 250LPM to approximately 55LPM over time due to a number of system faults presently existing. The two remaining refuelling stations are running at low efficiency and high risk of equipment break down or equipment failure is possible. Any system failure will negatively affect production which will result in significant revenue losses.

2. Proposed Scope of Work

Refuelling station No 1

- Install new TeleTech flow meter with flow range (0-500 LPM) or dipe DN50mm flanged both sides. The flow
 meter will be equipped with a mechanical veeder root counter and will have temperature compensation.
- Remove and refurbish the control valve on pipe DN50mm flanced of the side, then reinstall the refurbished control valve.

Refuelling station No 2 & 3

- Install new FloSolve wigging nozzle with flow lange (133 568 LPM) and operating pressure 125 PISG maximum.
- Remove and refurbish the control valve on N50mm pipe flanged both side, then reinstall the refrabrished control valve.

The scope of work includes upply, testing and commissioning of the following;

- Supply and install 2 new refuelling wigging nozzles with flow range (0 568LPM).

ANNEXURE D: SCOPE OF WORK AND SUMMARY OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR MACHENICAL ENGINEERING WORKS AT NSEZI LOCOMOTIVE DEPOT RICHARDS BAY

1. Provide adequate supports for the diesel feed and return lines with spill collection tray

The diesel feed line from the pump house to the diesel storage tanks broke at the flange next to the bund area then spilled diesel on the ground. This had a negative impact on environment which promoted the Department of Environmental Affairs to investigate. This incident was investigated and recommendations to prevent the similar incident from occurring were tabled for the depot to action. The feed line to the storage tank is loss and can break at any given time. During pumping of diesel to the storage tank this line rattles and it will break once more, resulting in the similar non-conformance occurred last year.

2. Proposed Scope of Work

Pipe line between storage tanks and pump house

- Stabilise the ground by compacted to layer by layer (150mm) ensure ground stability then cast 6 concrete base 3 bases will be at 500X500X1000 @ 25Mpa with steel re enforcement then 3 other bases will be at 500X500X500 @ 25Mpa with steel re enforcement. The spacing between the bases should be 4m from centre.
- Manufacture and supply galvanized steel structure with pipe support and collection spill tray @ 4.5mm plate; this structure should be mounted on the concrete base for proper stability.
- Relocate both pipes to a new position this pipes should be leser to each other (gap = 150mm), these pipes should have a gentle slope from the bund area wall towards the effluent drain next to the pump house.
- Approximately 4m of new pipe will be supplied for the deviation to ensure relocation is proper
- Raise the effluent bund wall by approximately 250mix to contain the spill flow rate.

Pipe dimensions

Diameter = 100 mmLength = 24 mHeight = 0.4 m

Pipe line between decarting area and pump house

- Stabilise the ground by compacted to layer by layer (150mm) ensure ground stability then cast 2 concrete base will be at 500X500X500 @ 25Mpa with steel re enforcement. The spacing between the bases should be 4m from centre
- Manufacture and supply galvanized steel structure with pipe support and collection spill tray @ 4.5mm plate; this
 structure should be mounted on the concrete base for proper stability. This spill tray will join to the bund area
 side.
- Relocate use the existing pipe this pipe should have a gentle slope from the decanting station area towards the
 effluent drain next to the pump house.

The scope of work includes supply, testing and commissioning of the following;

- Preparation of ground then cast 8 concrete bases.
- Supply and install 8 galvanised steel supports with spill collection tray.
- Raise the effluent bund wall by approximately 250mm to contain the spill flow rate.
