2 Compulsory Local Content Threshold

In terms of section 9(1) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, and the Instruction Note issued by National Treasury on the "Invitation and Evaluation of Bids based on a stipulated minimum threshold for local content and production for the **FOOTWEAR** Sector," Transnet is required to set a stipulated minimum threshold be set for this RFP.

2.1 Local Content Threshold

Declarations D and E should be kept by Respondents for verification purposes for a period of at least 5 years. The successful Respondent is required to continuously update Declarations C, D and E with the actual values for the duration of the contract. Although Annexure D and Annexure E need not be submitted with Proposals, Transnet reserves the right to call for these Supporting Schedules if required.

3 Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEE]

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Basid Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it would therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will accordingly allow a "preference" to companies who provide a valid B-BBEE Verification Certificate. All procurement transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

3.1 B-BBEE Scorecard and Rating

As prescribed in terms of the Preferencial Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are a note the following:

- In this RFQ, Transnet will apply the 20/20 preference point system prescribed in the PPPFA.
- Proposals will be evaluated an orice which will be allocated 80 points and preference which will be allocated 20 points
- The 80/20 preference point system applies where the acquisition of the Goods will be less than 11 00 000.00. However, if the 80/20 preference point system is stipulated in this RFQ and all bits received exceed R1 000 000.00, the RFQ will be cancelled.

compliance with the Government Gazette No 34612, Notice No. 754 dated 23 September 2011, from 1 October 2011 valid B-BBEE Verification Certificates must be issued by:

Verification Agencies accredited by the South African National Accreditation System [SANAS]; or

b) Registered Auditors approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors [**IRBA**], in accordance with the approval granted by the Department of Trade and Industry.

Enterprises will be rated by such agencies based on the following:

- a) Large Enterprises [i.e. annual turnover greater than R35 million]:
 - Rating level based on all seven elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- b) Qualifying Small Enterprises QSE [i.e. annual turnover between R5 million and R35 million]:
 - Rating based on any four of the elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- c) Exempted Micro Enterprises EME [i.e. annual turnover less than R5 million]:

In accordance with B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice [Statement 000, Section 4], any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R 5 million or less qualifies as an EME.

- Automatic rating of B-BBEE Level 4 irrespective of race or ownership
- Black ownership greater than 50% or Black Women ownership greater than 50% automatically qualify as B-BBEE Level 3

Sufficient evidence to qualify as an EME would be a certificate (which may be in the form of a letter) from an auditor or accounting officer or a certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS. The certificate must confirm the company's turnover, black ownership / black female ownership, B-BBEE status level and validity date.

Respondents are required to furnish proof of the above to Transnet. [i.e. a valid detailed scorecard as stipulated above in respect of Large Enterprises and QSEs, or a valid certificate in respect of EMEs].

Transnet will accordingly allocate a maximum of **20 [twenty] points** to the Respondent's final score based on an entity's B-BBEE scorecard rating. *[Refer Annyur A* – **B-BBEE Preference Points Claim Form** for further details].

N.B. Failure to submit a B-BBEE certificate, which is valid as at the Closing Date of this RFP, will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.
